

Privacy Policy

Oceandiare Energy Ltd owns and operates this website. We are committed to the privacy and security of our visitors' information. The following is a statement of our privacy practices:

Information Collected

- Your personal information is not required to visit www.expromedia.com.ng
- Any personal information collected is knowingly provided by you and only when requested/required during account registration for interactive participation on www.expromedia.com.ng and during an ordering process.

Traffic Data

- Your IP address is a numeric address assigned to your computer, assigned by your Internet service provider. We automatically collect your IP address as traffic data so that we can send information back to you when requested. This is not used to identify your personal information.
- Referrers are references to the web address you linked from and are automatically passed along by your web browser. We collect referrers your browser sends as part of traffic data. This is not attached to personally identifiable information.
- System information such as your operating system/platform, and the type of web browser you use. This is not attached to personally identifiable information.

Information Use

Account Information

- Your information is maintained on a secure web server in what we believe to be a well-protected environment.
- **Oceandiare Energy Ltd** only shares personal information with billing companies for completing transactions and for no other purpose. No other information is shared with any other third-party company for any purpose, under any circumstance.
- **Oceandiare Energy Ltd** makes every effort to preserve your privacy, personal information may be disclosed when required by law where we have a good-faith belief that such action is necessary to comply with a judicial proceeding, court order, or legal process.

Cookies

www.oceandiare.com. relies on “cookie” technology to allow you to re-access your “registered” account profile during a web session (If there’s any provision for that). This mechanism is employed solely for your convenience and for no other purpose.

Cookies – what they are

Cookies are small files that are stored by your web browser as you use the web.

They are designed to hold a tiny amount of data to allow websites to do things like remembering your settings, whether you are logged in or not, or whether you have visited the site before. By continuing to use our site you consent to our use of Cookies.

How and why this site uses cookies.

This website makes use of cookies for the following reasons.

Web Analytics

In common with most websites, we use a system to measure the amount of traffic to our site. This system is called Google Analytics and is provided to us by a company called Google. Google Analytics sets or updates cookies only to collect the data required for reporting.

It allows us to understand things like how many people have viewed our site in a given period, how often people visit, and what the most popular types of content are. We use this information to help us improve the site in lots of ways. For example, we may realize something we think is a particularly good bit of content is not being viewed as often as we would expect, we may then decide to make that content easier to find via the site navigation options.

Security

Only employees who need the information to perform a specific job (for example, our billing clerk or a customer service representative) are granted access to personally identifiable information. Finally, the servers that store personally identifiable information are in a secure environment, in a locked facility.
